### REGULATIONS

#### 1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

- The aim of the tournament is to encourage athletes to practise sport systematically, to develop attitudes of fair fight and noble behaviour.
- Tasks:
  - To promote judo sport in Lithuania and in the international arena, to search for gifted children, to create conditions for their development;
  - To identify the strongest athletes in different age groups.

#### 2. PARTICIPANTS

- **The competition will take place on September 21, 2024; 4 tatamis;**
- **One-day camp – September 22, 2024 from 10:00 to 12:00;**
- Boys and girls from sports centres and clubs participate in the tournament;
- The tournament is private;
- U18 Cadets (born 2007 – 2009)
  - Girls: -40 kg, -44 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg
  - Boys: -50 kg, -55 kg, -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg
- U15 Pre-cadets (born 2010 – 2012 and 2013 - at the discretion of the coach)
  - Girls: -40 kg, -44 kg, -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, +63 kg
  - Boys: -34 kg, -38 kg, -42 kg, -46 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg, -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, +81 kg
- Fight duration:
  - U18 – 4 minutes;
  - U15 – 3 minutes.
- U15 – up to 500 gr. overweight allowed;
- U15 – no breaking actions allowed.
